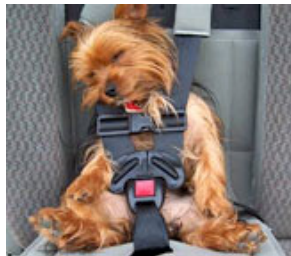
Along with the tall ships there will be several events taking place, including a Juried Art Exhibition, and an Octoberfest sponsored by the Chula Vista Yacht Club.

TOP 12 TIPS FOR TRAVELING WITH DOGS

Hey Buddy, wanna ride?

1. Get to the vet first. Carry a list of all vaccines with dates due or administered and essential doggie medications.
2. Dog Tags are so important. Calls to dog owners whose pet has wandered are numerous.
3. Pack -and plan-for your dog. Bring their favorite toy, bowl, food dish and of course don't forget the treats.
4. Be aware that different areas have different water systems, it is best to give your dog bottled water.
5. Use some restraint on your dog while driving.
6. Seat covers are always a good idea.
7. Make sure to cover the automatic window buttons so they won't accidentally operate with a misplaced paw.
8. Dogs love to hang out the window of a car but they can get injured by insects or road debris flying into their eyes or even fall out so take precaution.
9. Make sure your dog is as comfortable as you are. If you are hot your dog is hot, if you are cold your dog is probably cold too. Adjust accordingly.
10. Never leave your dog unattended in a locked car.
11. Take frequent breaks to water, feed and walk your dog.
12. Always pick up after your pets.
